The meeting was called to order at 7:35 p.m. The invocation and pledge of allegiance were led by Chet Drain and the minutes were read and accepted.

NBAs Report, *Dave Teegarden:* Not in attendance.

Legislative Report, *Mike Weir:* Reported that H.R. 237 the Vote at Home Act has been introduced. This bill would expand voting by mail in federal elections and provides for automatic voter registration through state motor vehicle authorities.

Retirees Report, *Tom Schulte:* Tom sent greetings from the retirees and reported that the final preparations are being done on the Ole Timers Luncheon where 22 retirees will be honored for their 50-, 60- and 70-year union membership.

Labor Council Report, *Pam Stepney:* Pam reported that medical marijuana is now legal after only a 15% voter turnout and that if you did not vote, you cannot complain.

MBA Report, *Saronda Sutherland:* Saronda reported that the MBA has a Hospital Plus plan that would pay as much as \$100 for every day of hospitalization. The plan is open to members, spouses, and children.

Health Benefit Report, *Barry Linan*: Barry reminded newly converted CCAs that if they have chosen the CCA health benefits, the policy expires 45 days after being converted to regular and not to wait the full 60 days before making a new health care benefit choice.

Mound City Carrier Report, *Tom Schulte:* Tom reminded everyone that the branch still has Cardinal baseball tickets for sale. See page 23 of the May issue.

Haake Scholarship Report, *Pam Stepney:* Pam reported that 10 applications and seven completed packets were received. None of the applicants applied for the trade school scholarship this year.
